SCALABLE MANUFACTURING AND EFFICIENT DELIVERY

No project is too large for Tuohy to handle. We have separate plants for casegoods, seating, and conference tables, so a large casegoods order does not impact seating or conference table lead times.

We also aim to make delivery and installation as efficient as possible. All offices are suite-matched and tagged for easy placement. We can deliver large projects directly to site, avoiding potential damage from over-handling, and we blanket-wrap products to speed up receiving and reduce packaging waste.



CUSTOM VENEERS

We own our own veneer panel company, Saunders Wood Specialties, and specialize in custom veneers as well as many standard options. Whether your project requires walnut, oak, maple, black limba, or figured Mozambique, we can bring your vision to life with nearly any type of veneer.

Our team at Saunders hand selects the finest veneers for our products, using book-matched veneers for plain-sliced cuts and slip-matched veneers for quarter-sawn cuts. This ensures balanced color, uniform appearance, and consistent grain.

HIGH-QUALITY DETAILS

When you partner with Tuohy, you can be confident that we are deeply committed to quality. You'll see this commitment in the following high-craft details:

- Doors and drawers feature soft-close mechanisms.
- All products are sanded and flat finished on all sides (never finished while fully or partially assembled).
- Drawer construction includes solid wood laminated English dovetail joinery.

RIGOROUS FINISH STANDARDS

Through proven engineering practices, we ensure that our finishes lead the industry in quality and durability. Our finish standards include:

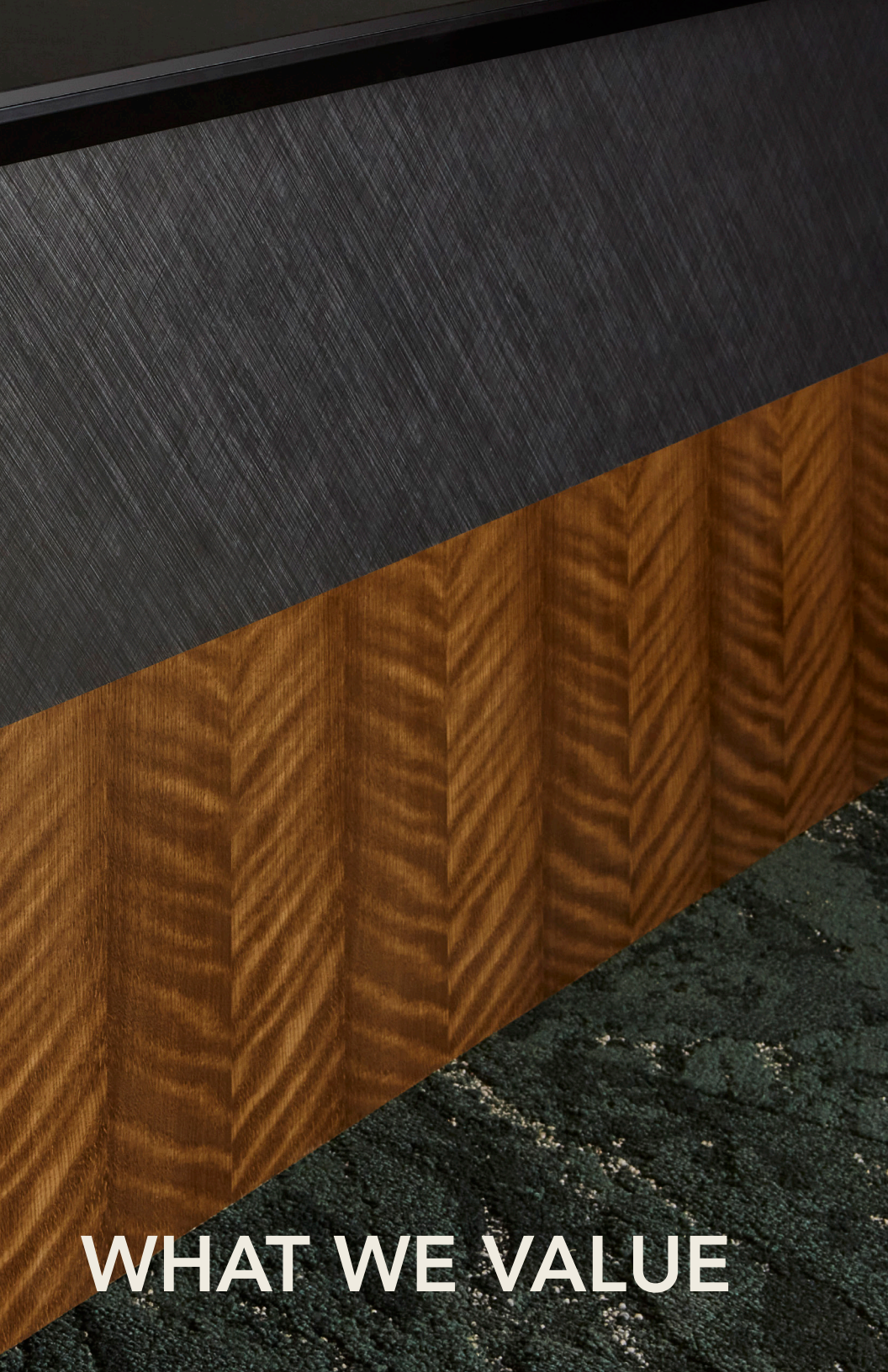
- Self-sealing, made from water-reducible acrylic.
- Hand sprayed and heated between each coat, ensuring a full cure.
- Hand sanded, tacked, and visually inspected prior to each finish application.
- Compliant with or surpassing KCMA test requirements for heat, cold, and stain spill.
- Compliant with or surpassing BIFMA requirements for hardness and rub testing.

CUSTOM CAPABILITIES

At Tuohy, we practice specific techniques that allow for customization and ensure superior quality. Parametric manufacturing enables us to resize each component in terms of width, depth, and height, allowing for custom applications and a bespoke aesthetic.

We encourage design freedom by offering custom edge details, hardware pulls, veneers, and finishes. Tops can range in thickness from 1.5–5", in nearly any size or finish including veneer, solid surface, stone, and granite. Other custom options include power accessibility, such as convenient surface grommet locations and integrated wire management solutions.
